Drive from Prescott to Williams. Drive time appx 1hr 20 min. The train enthusiast can ride the Grand Canyon Railway, and history buffs can explore what has been described as "the best preserved stretch of Route 66 from Santa Monica to Chicago."



Drive from Williams to Tusayan. Drive time appx 55 min. Tusayan (pronounced Too-Say-Ann), is located only 1 mile from the Grand Canyon National Park South Rim Entrance and is surrounded by the Kaibab National Forest, offering diverse landscapes, dark skies, abundant wildlife and peaceful soundscapes.
